Gods Only Way

Ever since the creation, man has sought to have his own way in religion. It started with Cain and continues today with people going in every direction but the right way in trying to be religious. People are being told they are saved when they "accept Jesus as your personal Saviour" and say the "sinner's prayer". Others are being told that God has already predestined the eternity of everyone and there is nothing you can do to change it. Both are scripturally wrong! It was written by an 8-year-old named Danny Dutton, who lives in Chula Vista, CA. He wrote it for his third grade homework assignment, to 'explain God.' I wonder if any of us could have done as well?

(and he had such an assignment in California, and someone published it, I guess miracles do happen!)

EXPLANATION OF GOD: 'One of God's main jobs is making people. He makes them to replace the ones that die, so there will be enough people to take care of things on earth.
