#### **Pastor's Corner**

## **Gods Wonderful Creation**

The only way we can know about the creation is from God who did the creating. Genesis 1:1 says, "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth." Everything was created by the power of God. The first thing God did was to create light and in Genesis 1:4 "God called the light day and the darkness night. So the evening and the morning was the first day." Each day including each day of the creation has light for day and darkness for the night. Also all six days of creation had both an evening and a morning (Genesis 1:5, 8, 13, 19, 23, 31) just like the days today.

God told Moses in Exodus 20:11, "For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea and all that is in them." God said that everything He created was created in these six days of creation. There was not a progressive creation spread out over billions of years.

In Genesis 1:24 we read, "And God said, let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind; and it was so." God is so powerful that all He has to do is to speak and it happens. Each produces after its own kind. There is no evolution from one kind to another because God said that each was to produce "according to its kind."

In Genesis 1:27& 2:7 we read, "So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them...and man became a living soul." We are created in the image of God; this is what makes us so special. All people have a soul that will live on forever in eternity either in Heaven or Hell. This is how we differ from the animals. But Psalms 33:8-9 says, "Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him, for He spoke and it was done."

In addition to recuperating Joan has substantial uncovered medical expenses associated with her lung transplant. A fund raising Gift of Song benefit cabaret in honor of Joan will be held on Friday January 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM at St. Paul's UCC Church located at 5 West Arch Street in Fleetwood. The cabaret night that includes many outstanding vocalists, is being presented by Hope Help Live a 501©(3) nonprofit organization that has been assisting patients like Joan for over 35 years.

Our Admin Board has asked for an all-out effort to support the efforts for Joan. There are many ways we can help in this effort, being a sponsor, providing a themed basket for silent auction, donating a gift card for the card pull, providing baked goods for the evening, attending and/or helping at the event and outright monetary contributions to Joan's fund. Glenn Sanders is coordinating donations from our Emmanuel congregation and is seeking non-monetary donations of items for auction or sale at the fund raiser. #### Hello Everyone!!

Thanks so much for all your help getting this event off the ground. I will never be able to repay everyone for all the kindness during this time. To say I am overwhelmed at this point is an understatement. I know several people have already started getting things together. Attached please find the paperwork you will need to give to the people that are donating to this event.

- There is a general letter about the Hope Help Live organization and info about my mom's fund. This link on this letter is for general donations to her fund. Not for tickets to the event.
- You will also see a 501C3 letter confirming the status so businesses and donors can report on their donation.
- There is also an In-Kind Donation form that you will need to give to anyone that is giving us products, anything that is not straight money. The donor will have to fill in the value of the item donated. We cannot apply value, unless you are personally donating something! I will need copies of all the forms as well, so have two on hand, one for the person/business and one to fill out to give to me for record keeping.

• I will need info on everything that is collected, names, addresses, value, etc. even if there is a note with this info taped to each item, so I can log it for the event.

We are doing a suggested donation of \$30 for the tickets to the event. You can use this link for the tickets. <u>https://admin.helphopelive.org/event/5140/signup</u> There is not a physical ticket. I will print a list of people that have paid, and we will check them off at the door. We will also sell "tickets" at the door but would like as many people as possible to buy ahead of time, so we know what to expect. If we have too many people, we will move the show to the main church.
