Pastor's Corner

Why Read the Bible?

For many years it was reported that the Bible was the best seller. That simply means that a lot of people were buying Bibles; it does not necessarily mean that all who bought Bibles were reading them. Many do

read and study God's word and they do so for various reasons. Some read the Bible out of mere curiosity. Others read the Scriptures to satisfy their literary pride while others read in order to be able to disprove those who disagree with them. There are those who read their Bibles out of a sheer sense of duty. All of this to say, that it is possible to read God's word without any desire to know God, without any longing for personal spiritual benefit. In such cases there is little or no spiritual profit which results from the time and effort put forth.

The word of God tells us, "All Scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be adequate, equipped for every good work". In other words, the word of God is profitable in certain specific areas. The word of God teaches, reproves, corrects, and trains in righteousness to the end that you might be prepared to do every good work. When you are truly profiting from God's word it ought to be obvious in several areas. First of all, there are many truths which only the word of God can teach us. We need to know the truth about the true and living God, about the origin and future of man, the true nature and consequence of sin and of God's remedy for sin. It is vitally important that we understand why Christ was God incarnate and why He lived and died as a Substitute for others.

If you are profiting from God's word, as you read it, you will be called to account for those things in your life that God disapproves of. When person is convicted of sin, for the first time they begin to sense something of the desperate need of their soul. They are brought to that place where they are able to see that Christ is the only One who is perfectly suited to meet that need. If indeed a person brought to trust Christ as Lord and Savior, it can be said that they have profited from reading God's word. The word of God also corrects and instructs. The proof of whether or not a person has been corrected and instructed by God's word is whether or not they are seeking to live in accordance with God's revealed will.

Sad to say, many who read the Bible fall into the category described by the Apostle James as "hearers only." He makes a great distinction between "hearers" and "doers." "But prove yourselves doers of the word, and not merely hearers who delude themselves." James 1:22 The only way to know the truth is to read God's word with a sincere desire to obey it.

Evelyn Kent Clark appointed to be our new South District superintendent

Bishop Peggy A. Johnson would like to announce the appointment of the Rev. Evelyn Kent Clark as the Superintendent of the South District of the Eastern Pennsylvania Conference effective July 1, 2020. She follows the Rev. Dawn Taylor-Storm who will be the new Director of Connectional Ministries at the Conference Office effective July 1, 2020.

Rev. Clark grew up in Philadelphia, PA with her three sisters and one brother. She was educated in the parochial school system of Philadelphia and upon graduation from high school she attended Lincoln University in Oxford, PA with a major in French and a minor in Secondary Education. Rev. Clark responded to the call to ordained ministry after 13 years as an educator in the public-school system. She received her Local Pastor's License in 1993 and her Masters of Divinity from Eastern Baptist Theological Seminary, currently known as Palmer Seminary, in 2000. She was ordained

as an elder in the United Methodist Church in 2003 and is currently serving as the pastor of two churches in the Eastern Pennsylvania Conference: New Life UMC in Drexel Hill, PA and Trinity Lansdowne UMC (known as The Garden Church) in historic Lansdowne, PA.

Rev. Clark served the General Church as a member of the General Board of Discipleship. She has also served as a member of the Congregational Transformation Team, co-chairperson of Calling Disciples Resource Team, member of the Commission on Equitable Compensation, president of Black United Methodist Preachers, member of Black Methodist for Church Renewal

and as the secretary and chairperson of the Committee on Episcopacy. She is currently chairperson of the Order of Elders, co-chairperson of the South District Committee on Ordained Ministry and a member of the Board of Ordained Ministry and its executive committee.

Rev. Clark was a facilitator for the Forum for Female Scholars at the 2006 Gates Millennium Scholars Leadership Conference in Chantilly, Virginia. In that same year Rev. Clark received the Denman Award for evangelism. In March of 2007 she accepted an invitation to the University of Oxford, in Oxford, England to present and dialogue on the topic "Science and Religion: Is There Common Ground?" She is a member of Biltmore Who's Who, having qualified for inclusion in the 2007-2008 edition of the registry of executives and professionals. In 2017 Rev. Clark had the extreme honor of being a recipient of the Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award by President Barak Obama.


